

Recap of 12/28/25 message by Pastor Chris Sommerfield

2 Samuel 7: 1-29 “Building a Forever House”

This passage reassures us that God’s plans transcend our understanding and that, as heirs of His promises, we can live confidently, trusting in His divine orchestration. We see David’s desire to build God a temple, but God plans to build David a forever house. He will build a dynasty that will never cease, and we see this in the connection between Jesus as the Messiah and King in the line of David. He was the descendant of David whose kingdom would last. He was the descendant who would establish a real temple—not a building constructed with human hands but the temple of His own body. And after His ascension He would send His Spirit to make us, His people, the temple of God. We should ask ourselves do we desire to serve God and live for Him as David demonstrates in this passage. He shows a desire to build something for the LORD! Do you have this desire? What do you desire to build for the LORD? What may He bear building for you?
